Tyler: No... but look at your name on my phone.

Michelle: Did you change my last name to your last name?

Tyler: Yeah, I did. Aren't we dating seriously?

Michelle: Yeah, but I'm not thinking about marriage anytime soon.

Tyler: Don't worry about it babe, it's just an inside joke.

Michelle: Also, why was your mom asking when you were coming home? Don't you live alone?

Tyler: Oh, she's just visiting me because she has vacation days.

Michelle: And you're not with her now?

Tyler: She said she was having dinner or something with my aunt.

Michelle: Oh, okay.

Tyler: Hey you wanna get a late night snack?

Michelle: You know I always do.

Tyler: Ice cream?

Michelle: Yeah, let's go to the ice cream shop in town.

Tyler: I'll drive.

(car starting noise)

Michelle: Oh, I think I stepped on something, sorry.

Tyler: It's no problem. What is it? Michelle: Let me see. Oh. Um... It's lipstick. Tyler: Oh, I think it's my mom's. Michelle: Your mom wears black lipstick? Tyler: What? Michelle: This lipstick is black. Tyler: Uh... yeah, she's a cool mom. Michelle: Uh... okay... It's cute? I actually really like this brand. It's really popular right now. Tyler: Oh, really? Michelle: Yeah it was sold out. Everyone had to order it online. Tyler: I guess my mom is just good at technology. Michelle: Yeah, I guess she is cool. Tyler: Alright, we're here. Let's go. Uh, can you give that lipstick back to me? (transition music)

Narrator: That's the end of the first scene. The next scene happens a few weeks later.

(Michelle's house, day)
(knock on the door, door opens)
James: Hey!
Michelle: Hey.
James: You ready to go to the library?
Michelle: (sigh) I guess so.
James: What's with the sigh? Are you okay today?

Michelle: It's nothing.

James: It doesn't sound like "nothing".

Michelle: (sigh) It's just boy drama.

James: Oh, I love boy drama! Tell me.

Michelle: (sigh) Well... it's a lot of things.

James: Like what?

Michelle: Well, I'm not sure if graduation is making me more stressed, or if there's actually a

problem.

James: Wait, this is with Tyler, right?

Michelle: Of course.

James: Oh, fighting with your first boyfriend?

Michelle: No, we don't really fight.

James: Then what is it?

Michelle: He hasn't been texting me a lot lately.

James: Okay?

Michelle: And we don't really go on dates anymore. We just always hang out at my house at

night and then he goes home.

Michelle: Not really. It's just been bothering me recently.

James: Mhm
